Subchapter C, Chapter 2151, Occupations Code, is 4 5 amended by adding Section 2151.1013 to read as follows: Sec. 2151.1013. RIDE OPERATOR SAFETY REQUIREMENTS. (a) In 6 7 this section: (1) "Dispatcher" means a ride operator stationed at 8 9 the top of an elevated waterslide amusement ride to maintain order, direct patrons departing the top of the slide, and ensure patrons 10 begin the ride safely. 11 12 (2) "Ride operator" means a person who directly controls or has the duty to directly control the operation of an 13 14 amusement ride. The term does not include a certified lifeguard, other than a certified lifeguard working as a dispatcher. 15 16 (b) A ride operator must be: (1) at least 16 years of age; and 17 18 (2) trained in the proper use and operation of the 19 amusement ride the person is operating. 20 (c) A ride operator may not simultaneously operate more than one amusement ride unless the operator is a dispatcher for adjacent 21 or proximate elevated waterslide amusement rides. 22 23 (d) A ride operator may not operate an amusement ride if the operator's operation of the ride constitutes an offense under 24
