- 5 SECTION 1. Section 46.02, Penal Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-5) to read as

- 8 (a) A person commits an offense if the person:
- 9 (1) intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly carries
- 10 on or about his or her person a firearm [handgun]; and
- 11 (2) is not:
- 12 (A) on the person's own premises or premises
- 13 under the person's control; or
- 14 (B) inside of or directly en route to a motor
- 15 vehicle or watercraft that is owned by the person or under the
- 16 person's control.
- 17 <u>(a-5)</u> It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (a)
- 18 <u>that:</u>
- (1) the actor was carrying a firearm other than a
- 20 <u>handgun</u>;
- 21 (2) the actor was on a premises owned by another or was
- 22 inside of or directly en route to a motor vehicle or watercraft that
- 23 is owned by another;
- 24 (3) the owner of the premises, motor vehicle, or

- 1 watercraft gave the actor verbal or written authorization to carry
- 2 the firearm on the premises or in the motor vehicle or watercraft,
- 3 as applicable;
- 4 (4) carrying or possessing a firearm other than a
- 5 handgun on those premises or in the motor vehicle or watercraft is
- 6 not otherwise prohibited under this chapter or other law; and
- 7 (5) the premises, vehicle, or watercraft is not open
- 8 to or accessible by the public.
- 9 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 10 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 11 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 12 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
- 13 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 14 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 15 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
