(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a burn boss is not 10 liable for property damage, personal injury, or death caused by or 11 resulting from the burn in excess of the insurance requirements 12 established by the board under Section 153.046 if the burn boss has: 13 14 (1) completed an accredited prescribed burning training course approved by the board; and 15 16 (2) satisfied the experience requirements prescribed 17 by the board. (c) This section does not apply to a burn boss who commits 18 19 gross negligence or intentionally causes property damage, personal 20 injury, or death. 21 SECTION 2. Section 153.084, Natural Resources Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on 22 23 or after the effective date of this Act. 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
