A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating to the appointment of an individual to a school district
3	board of managers by the commissioner of education.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 39A, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 39A.2045 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 39A.2045. CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION REVIEW:
- 8 BOARD OF MANAGERS. (a) Before the commissioner appoints a board of
- 9 managers under this chapter, the agency shall review the criminal
- 10 history record information that relates to each person to be
- 11 appointed by the commissioner to serve as a member of that board.
- 12 (b) The agency is authorized to obtain from the Department
- 13 of Public Safety criminal history record information maintained by
- 14 the department as necessary to comply with Subsection (a).
- 15 (c) In addition to the information the agency is authorized
- 16 to obtain under Section 411.0901, Government Code, and this
- 17 section, the agency is authorized to request and obtain criminal
- 18 <u>history record information through the Federal Bureau of</u>
- 19 <u>Investigation as provided by Section 411.087, Government Code.</u>
- 20 (d) The agency shall adopt rules as necessary to implement
- 21 this section.

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- SECTION 2. Section 411.0901(a), Government Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- 24 (a) The Texas Education Agency is entitled to obtain

- 1 criminal history record information maintained by the department
- 2 about a person who:
- 3 (1) is employed or is an applicant for employment by a
- 4 school district or open-enrollment charter school;
- 5 (2) is employed or is an applicant for employment by a
- 6 shared services arrangement, if the employee's or applicant's
- 7 duties are or will be performed on school property or at another
- 8 location where students are regularly present; [or]
- 9 (3) is employed or is an applicant for employment by an
- 10 entity that contracts with a school district, open-enrollment
- 11 charter school, or shared services arrangement if:
- 12 (A) the employee or applicant has or will have
- 13 continuing duties relating to the contracted services; and
- 14 (B) the employee or applicant has or will have
- 15 direct contact with students; or
- 16 (4) is appointed or is to be appointed by the
- 17 commissioner of education to serve as a member of a board of
- 18 managers under Subchapter E, Chapter 39A, Education Code.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
