A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the employment of certified school counselors to comply
- 3 with the ratio requirement of counselors to public school students.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 33.002(b) and (c), Education Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A school district with 250 [500] or more students
- 8 enrolled in elementary school grades shall employ a school
- 9 counselor certified under the rules of the State Board for Educator
- 10 Certification for each elementary school in the district. A school
- 11 district shall employ at least one school counselor for every 250
- 12 [500] elementary school students in the district.
- 13 (c) A school district with fewer than 250 [500] students
- 14 enrolled in elementary school grades shall provide guidance and
- 15 counseling services to elementary school students by:
- 16 (1) employing a part-time school counselor certified
- 17 under the rules of the State Board for Educator Certification;
- 18 (2) employing a part-time teacher certified as a
- 19 school counselor under the rules of the State Board for Educator
- 20 Certification; or
- 21 (3) entering into a shared services arrangement
- 22 agreement with one or more school districts to share a school
- 23 counselor certified under the rules of the State Board for Educator
- 24 Certification.

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
- 2 school year.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
