6 SECTION 1. Section 161.133(a), Health and Safety Code, is

8 (a) The executive commissioner by rule shall require each

inpatient mental health facility, treatment facility, or hospital

that provides comprehensive medical rehabilitation services to

11 annually provide as a condition of continued licensure a minimum of

12 eight hours of <u>initial</u> inservice training <u>for new employees and</u>

13 four hours of continuing inservice training for continuing

14 employees that is designed to assist employees and health care

15 professionals associated with the facility in identifying patient

16 abuse or neglect and illegal, unprofessional, or unethical conduct

17 by or in the facility.

SECTION 2. Section 161.133(a), Health and Safety Code, as

19 amended by this Act, applies to the minimum number of inservice

20 training hours provided as a condition of initial or continued

21 licensure by certain health care facilities subject to that section

22 on and after the effective date of this Act. The minimum number of

23 inservice training hours provided before the effective date of this
