A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to inservice training on prevention of abuse, neglect, and 3 illegal, unprofessional, and unethical conduct provided by certain 4 health care facilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 161.133(a), Health and Safety Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:

(a) The executive commissioner by rule shall require each 8 inpatient mental health facility, treatment facility, or hospital 9 that provides comprehensive medical rehabilitation services to 10 11 annually provide as a condition of continued licensure a minimum of four [eight] hours of inservice training designed to assist 12 employees and health care professionals associated with the 13 14 facility in identifying patient abuse or neglect and illegal, unprofessional, or unethical conduct by or in the facility. 15

SECTION 2. Section 161.133(a), Health and Safety Code, as 16 amended by this Act, applies only to the minimum number of inservice 17 training hours provided as a condition of continued licensure by 18 certain health care facilities subject to that section on and after 19 the effective date of this Act. The minimum number of inservice 20 21 training hours provided before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date 22 23 of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that 24 purpose.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
