## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the composition of the districts for the election of
- 3 members of the State Board of Education.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Act is to fulfill
- 6 the Legislature's responsibility to establish districts for the
- 7 election of members of the State Board of Education following the
- 8 publication of the 2020 census in compliance with the United States
- 9 and Texas Constitutions and applicable Federal and state law.
- 10 SECTION 2. FINDINGS. The Legislature finds:
- 11 (1) Section 7.101, Education Code, requires the
- 12 election of members of the board from districts;
- 13 (2) As a result of the estimated rate of growth in the
- 14 population of the state since 2011, the populations of the current
- 15 districts for the election of members of the board are unequal and
- 16 no longer comply with applicable legal requirements; and
- 17 (3) The current districts must be replaced following
- 18 publication of the decennial census with new districts that satisfy
- 19 all applicable legal requirements.
- 20 SECTION 3. COMPOSITION OF DISTRICTS. (a) The State of
- 21 Texas is composed of 15 board of education districts as provided in
- 22 this Act. Each district is composed of the counties or parts of
- 23 counties as determined by the Legislature consistent with the
- 24 requirements of the United States and Texas Constitutions and

- 1 applicable Federal law.
- 2 (b) One member of the board is elected from each district
- 3 established by this Act.
- 4 (c) For purposes of Section 7.104, Education Code, this Act
- 5 constitutes a decennial reapportionment.
- 6 SECTION 4. TRANSITION PROVISION. The districts established
- 7 by this Act apply to the election of the members of the State Board
- 8 of Education beginning with the primary and general elections in
- 9 2022. This Act does not affect the membership or districts of the
- 10 board before January 1, 2023.
- SECTION 5. REPEALER. Chapter 72 (H.B. 600), Acts of the
- 12 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, is repealed.
- 13 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 14 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 15 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 16 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 17 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
