1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the use of the compensatory education allotment for
 1-23 programs that build certain social and emotional skills.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 48.104(j-1), Education Code, is amended
 1-26 to read as follows:

1-27 (j-1) In addition to other purposes for which funds
 1-28 allocated under this section may be used, those funds may also be
 1-29 used to:

1-30 (1) provide child-care services or assistance with
 1-31 child-care expenses for students at risk of dropping out of school
 1-32 under ~~[, as described by]~~ Section 29.081(d) because the students are
 1-33 parents [29.081(a)(5)]; ~~[or]~~

1-34 (2) pay the costs associated with services provided
 1-35 through a life skills program in accordance with Sections
 1-36 29.085(b)(1) and (3)-(7); or

1-37 (3) provide programs that build skills related to
 1-38 managing emotions, establishing and maintaining positive
 1-39 relationships, and making responsible decisions.

1-40 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-41 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-42 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-43 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-44 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
