Article 18B.202(c), Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read as follows: 6 (c) The affidavit must: 7 8 (1)state the name, department, agency, and address of 9 the applicant; identify the vehicle, container, or item to which, 10 (2) in which, or on which the mobile tracking device is to be attached, 11 12 placed, or otherwise installed; 13 (3) state the name of the owner or possessor of the 14 vehicle, container, or item identified under Subdivision (2); (4) state the judicial jurisdictional area in which 15 16 the vehicle, container, or item identified under Subdivision (2) is expected to be found; and 17 18 (5) state the facts and circumstances that provide the applicant with probable cause to believe [a reasonable suspicion] 19 20 that: 21 (A) criminal activity has been, is, or will be 22 committed; and the installation and use of a mobile tracking 23 (B) 24 device is likely to produce information that is material to an

ongoing criminal investigation of that criminal activity.
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
