## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the period for which a school district's participation
- 3 in certain tax increment financing reinvestment zones may be taken
- 4 into account in determining the total taxable value of property in
- 5 the school district.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 403.302, Government Code, is amended by
- 8 adding Subsection (e-2) to read as follows:
- 9 <u>(e-2)</u> This subsection applies only to a reinvestment zone
- 10 created by a municipality that has a population of 1.1 million or
- 11 more and is predominantly located in a county that has a population
- 12 of 1.8 million or less. Notwithstanding Subsection (e), if the
- 13 municipality adopts an ordinance designating a termination date for
- 14 the zone that is later than the termination date designated in the
- 15 ordinance creating the zone, the number of years for which the total
- 16 dollar amount may be deducted under Subsection (d)(4) is limited to
- 17 the duration of the zone as determined under Section 311.017, Tax
- 18 <u>Code.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
