A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT relating to the administration of a veterans treatment court 2 3 program. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 124.003(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) A veterans treatment court program established under this chapter shall make, establish, and publish local procedures to 8 9 ensure maximum participation of eligible defendants in the program [county or counties in which those defendants reside]. 10 11 SECTION 2. Sections 124.006(a) and (d), Government Code, 12 are amended to read as follows: (a) A veterans treatment court program that 13 accepts placement of a defendant may transfer responsibility 14 for supervising the defendant's participation in the program to another 15 16 veterans treatment court program that is located in the county where the defendant works or resides or in a county adjacent to the 17 county where the defendant works or resides. The defendant's 18 supervision may be transferred under this section only with the 19 consent of both veterans treatment court programs and the 20 21 defendant.

(d) If a defendant is charged with an offense in a county that does not operate a veterans treatment court program, the court in which the criminal case is pending may place the defendant in a

veterans treatment court program located in the county where the defendant works or resides <u>or in a county adjacent to the county</u> <u>where the defendant works or resides</u>, provided that a program is operated in that county and the defendant agrees to the placement. A defendant placed in a veterans treatment court program in accordance with this subsection must agree to abide by all rules, requirements, and instructions of the program.

8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
