5	SECTION 1. Section 29.906(b), Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(b) The State Board of Education must include the following
8	positive character traits:
9	(1) courage;
10	(2) trustworthiness, including honesty, reliability,
11	punctuality, and loyalty;
12	(3) integrity;
13	(4) respect and courtesy;
14	(5) responsibility, including accountability,
15	diligence, perseverance, and self-control;
16	(6) fairness, including justice <u>,</u> [ <del>and</del> ] freedom from
17	prejudice, and the importance of diversity, equity, and inclusion;
18	(7) caring, including kindness, empathy, compassion,
19	consideration, patience, generosity, and charity;
20	(8) good citizenship, including patriotism, concern
21	for the common good and the community, and respect for authority and
22	the law;
23	(9) school pride; and

(10) gratitude.

- 2 school year.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
