A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to food allergen awareness in food service establishments.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Sergio Lopez Allergy
5	Awareness Act.
6	SECTION 2. Chapter 437, Health and Safety Code, is amended
7	by adding Section 437.026 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 437.026. FOOD ALLERGEN AWARENESS. (a) A food service
9	establishment shall display a poster relating to food allerger
10	awareness in an area of the establishment accessible primarily to
11	<pre>food service employees of the establishment. The department shall:</pre>
12	(1) determine the form and content of the poster;
13	(2) post a sample poster on the department's Internet
14	website; and
15	(3) update the poster as necessary to ensure that the
16	poster contains current information about food allergens.
17	(b) A food service establishment may display the
18	information from the sample poster in lieu of the poster, provided
19	the information is presented and posted in a manner that is easily
20	readable by the establishment's food service employees in the
21	selected employee area.
22	(c) The poster or posted information must:
23	(1) state that a reaction to a food allergen is
24	potentially life-threatening; and

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1	(2) include information regarding:
2	(A) the risk of an allergic reaction to a food
3	allergen;
4	(B) the major food allergens, including milk,
5	wheat, eggs, soy, crustacean shellfish, peanuts, tree nuts, and
6	fish;
7	(C) the proper methods and procedures for
8	checking ingredients in food items, including unexpected or hidden
9	ingredients;
10	(D) the importance of clear communication
11	between customers with food allergies and the establishment's staff
12	concerning food allergens; and
13	(E) methods for preventing cross-contact in food
14	preparation.
15	(d) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary
16	to implement this section.
17	(e) This section does not create a private cause of action
18	or change any common law or statutory duty.
19	SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2021:
20	(1) the Department of State Health Services shall
21	determine the form and content of the poster and post the sample

poster on the department's Internet website as required by Section

Services Commission shall adopt any rules necessary to implement

SECTION 4. Notwithstanding Section 437.026, Health and
