8	ANOTHER STATE. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, the board shall
9	issue an unrestricted license under this chapter to an applicant
10	who is licensed in good standing as a physician in another state and
11	who satisfies the requirements of this section.
12	(b) The board may not issue a license under this section to
13	an applicant who:
14	(1) has had a medical license suspended or revoked by
15	another state or a Canadian province; or
16	(2) holds a medical license issued by another state or
17	a Canadian province that is subject to a restriction, disciplinary
18	order, or probationary order.
19	(c) An applicant under this section must:
20	(1) have passed a national or other examination
21	recognized by the board relating to the practice of medicine within
22	the number of attempts allowed under Section 155.056 or 155.0561,

as applicable; and

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(2) submit information to enable the board to conduct

- 1 a criminal background check as required by the board.
- 2 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 3 to an applicant for a physician license who submits an application
- 4 on or after January 1, 2022.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
