## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a peace officer's duty to display and provide the 3 officer's name and identification number; creating a criminal offense. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended by adding Article 2.1301 to read as follows: 7 Art. 2.1301. DUTY TO DISPLAY AND PROVIDE NAME AND 8 IDENTIFICATION NUMBER. (a) A peace officer who is discharging an 9 official duty and is not undercover shall: 10 11 (1) display in a visible manner at all times the 12 officer's first and last name and badge number or other identification number; and 13 14 (2) provide the officer's first and last name and badge number or other identification number to any person on request. 15 16 (b) A peace officer wearing riot gear that includes a helmet or a shield is considered to have complied with Subsection (a)(1) 17 only if the officer displays the required information on each of 18 those items, as applicable. 19 (c) A peace officer commits an offense if the officer 20 violates Subsection (a)(2). An offense under this subsection is a 21 22 Class C misdemeanor. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 23
