(a) А municipality by ordinance may regulate the parking of motor 8 9 vehicles on private property and may enforce the ordinance in the same manner that it enforces ordinances regulating parking in 10 public no-parking zones, including the impoundment of offending 11 12 vehicles. 13 (b) As provided by Chapter 682, Transportation Code, a 14 municipality with a population of 1.9 million or more may: (1) declare the violation of a municipal ordinance 15 16 relating to the parking of an unattended motor vehicle in the front or side yard of a single-family residence in a residential area to 17 be a civil offense; and 18 19 (2) by ordinance establish an administrative adjudication hearing procedure under which a civil fine may be 20 imposed. 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 22
