H.B. No. 523

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the enforcement of commercial motor vehicle safety
3 standards in certain counties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 644.101(c), Transportation Code, as
6 amended by Chapters 169 (H.B. 917) and 478 (H.B. 511), Acts of the
7 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 2019, is reenacted and amended
8 to read as follows:

9 (c) A sheriff or a deputy sheriff of any of the following
10 counties is eligible to apply for certification under this section:

- 11 (1) a county bordering the United Mexican States;
- 12 (2) a county with a population of less than 1,000, part
13 of which is located within 75 miles of an international border; ~~or~~
- 14 (3) ~~(2)~~ a county with a population of 700,000 or
15 more; ~~or~~
- 16 (4) (3) a county with a population of 400,000 or
17 more that borders the county in which the State Capitol is located;
18 or
- 19 (5) a county:
- 20 (A) any part of which is within 30 miles of New
21 Mexico; and
- 22 (B) that is adjacent to two or more counties that
23 generated \$100 million or more in tax revenue collected under
24 Chapters 201 and 202, Tax Code, from oil and gas production during

1 the preceding state fiscal year.

2 SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
3 over another Act of the 87th Legislature, Regular Session, 2021,
4 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
5 codes.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
