- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 251, Agriculture Code, is amended by
- 10 adding Section 251.007 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 251.007. REGULATION OF WORKING ANIMALS. (a) In this
- 12 section, "working animal" means an animal used for the purpose of
- 13 performing a specific duty or function, including entertainment,
- 14 transportation, or education.
- 15 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a political subdivision
- 16 may not impose a governmental requirement that terminates, bans, or
- 17 effectively bans by imposing an undue financial hardship, the job
- 18 or use of a working animal or an enterprise that employs a working
- 19 animal.
- 20 <u>(c) A governmental requirement adopted by a political</u>
- 21 subdivision that violates Subsection (b) is void.
- SECTION 3. Section 251.007, Agriculture Code, as added by
- 23 this Act, applies to a governmental requirement adopted before, on,
- 24 or after the effective date of this Act.
