A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to prohibited retaliation against state or local public
- 3 employees for reporting certain violations of law.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 554.002(a), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A state or local governmental entity may not suspend or
- 8 terminate the employment of, or take other adverse personnel action
- 9 against, a public employee who in good faith reports a violation of
- 10 law by the employing governmental entity or another public employee
- 11 to:
- 12 (1) the reporting employee's immediate supervisor, or
- 13 an individual who holds a position above the reporting employee's
- 14 immediate supervisor, at the employing governmental entity;
- 15 (2) an individual or office designated by the
- 16 employing governmental entity as the individual or office for
- 17 reporting such grievances;
- 18 (3) a member of the human resources staff of the
- 19 employing governmental entity; or
- 20 (4) an appropriate law enforcement authority.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 554.009, Government Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- Sec. 554.009. NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES. (a) A state or local
- 24 governmental entity shall inform its employees of their rights

- 1 under this chapter by:
- 2 (1) posting a sign in a prominent location in the
- 3 workplace; and
- 4 (2) providing its employees with a copy of the
- 5 anti-retaliation policy adopted by the entity under Section
- 6 554.0095.
- 7 (b) The attorney general shall:
- 8 $\underline{\text{(1)}}$ prescribe the design and content of the sign
- 9 required by Subsection (a)(1); and
- 10 (2) post in a prominent location on the attorney
- 11 general's Internet website:
- 12 (A) a summary of the rights of public employees
- 13 under this chapter; and
- 14 (B) a notice informing public employees of:
- (i) the ability to obtain a copy of the
- 16 <u>anti-retaliation policy adopted by their employing governmental</u>
- 17 entity under Section 554.0095 from an individual described by
- 18 Section 554.002(a)(1), (2), or (3); and
- 19 (ii) the requirement that an employing
- 20 governmental entity provide a copy of the entity's anti-retaliation
- 21 policy to each public employee on the first day of the employee's
- 22 employment with the entity [this section].
- SECTION 3. Chapter 554, Government Code, is amended by
- 24 adding Section 554.0095 to read as follows:
- Sec. 554.0095. ANTI-RETALIATION POLICY. (a) A state or
- 26 local governmental entity shall:
- 27 (1) develop and adopt an anti-retaliation policy

- 1 consistent with this chapter that:
- 2 (A) informs its employees of their rights under
- 3 this chapter and the anti-retaliation policy; and
- 4 (B) lists the individuals to whom its employees
- 5 may report a violation of law under Section 554.002(a);
- 6 (2) provide a copy of the anti-retaliation policy
- 7 adopted under Subdivision (1) to each employee on the first day of
- 8 the employee's employment with the entity; and
- 9 (3) notify its employees of any change made to its
- 10 anti-retaliation policy by e-mail, memorandum, or any other manner
- 11 that ensures each employee will be informed of the change.
- 12 (b) If an employee of a state or local governmental entity
- 13 requests a copy of the entity's anti-retaliation policy from an
- 14 individual described by Section 554.002(a)(1), (2), or (3), the
- 15 individual shall provide the employee with a copy of the policy.
- SECTION 4. Not later than December 1, 2021, a state or local
- 17 governmental entity, as defined by Section 554.001, Government
- 18 Code, shall develop and adopt an anti-retaliation policy as
- 19 required by Section 554.0095, Government Code, as added by this
- 20 Act.
- 21 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
