4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 545.0571 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 545.0571. MOTOR VEHICLE PASSING PEDESTRIAN OR BICYCLE
8	OPERATOR. (a) An operator of a motor vehicle shall exercise due
9	care to avoid colliding with a pedestrian or a person operating a
10	bicycle on a highway or street.
11	(b) For the purposes of Section 545.053(a), safe distance
12	from a pedestrian or any part of a bicycle is:
13	(1) at least three feet if the operator's vehicle is a
14	passenger car or a light truck; or
15	(2) at least six feet if the operator's vehicle is a
16	commercial motor vehicle as defined by Section 522.003 or a truck
17	other than a light truck.
18	(c) For the purposes of Section 545.057(a), conditions
19	permit safely passing a pedestrian or a bicycle to the right only if
20	the motor vehicle passes:
21	(1) at least three feet from the pedestrian or any part
22	of the bicycle if the operator's vehicle is a passenger car or a
23	light truck; or
24	(2) at least six feet from the pedestrian or any part

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1 of the bicycle if the operator's vehicle is a commercial motor 2 vehicle as defined by Section 522.003 or a truck other than a light 3 <u>truck.</u>

(d) An operator of a motor vehicle passing a pedestrian or a
person operating a bicycle on a highway or street that has two or
more marked lanes running in the same direction shall move the motor
vehicle to a lane other than the lane used by the pedestrian or
bicycle operator while passing the pedestrian or bicycle operator.

9 <u>(e) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under this</u> 10 <u>section that at the time of the offense the pedestrian or bicycle</u> 11 <u>operator was acting in violation of a traffic law in a manner that</u> 12 <u>contributed to the offense under this section.</u>

SECTION 2. Section 545.055, Transportation Code, is amended wavenue and the section (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

(b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), an [An] operator may not drive on the left side of the roadway in a no-passing zone or on the left side of any pavement striping designed to mark a no-passing zone.

20 (b-1) Subsection (b) [This subsection] does not prohibit a 21 driver from:

22 (1) crossing pavement striping, or the center line in 23 a no-passing zone marked by signs only, to make a left turn into or 24 out of an alley or private road or driveway; or

25 (2) passing a pedestrian or a person operating a
 26 bicycle in a no-passing zone if the operator of the motor vehicle
 27 otherwise complies with the requirements of this chapter.

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1 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An 2 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed 3 4 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 5 6 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 7 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
