## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to highway maintenance or construction vehicles and
3	certain service vehicles.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 545.157(a), Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) This section applies only to the following vehicles:
8	(1) a stationary authorized emergency vehicle using
9	visual signals that meet the requirements of Sections 547.305 and
10	547.702;
11	(2) a stationary tow truck using equipment authorized
12	by Section 547.305(d); [and]
13	(3) a Texas Department of Transportation vehicle <u>or a</u>
14	highway maintenance or construction vehicle operated pursuant to a
15	contract awarded under Subchapter A, Chapter 223, not separated
16	from the roadway by a traffic control channelizing device and using
17	visual signals that comply with the standards and specifications
18	adopted under Section 547.105;
19	(4) a service vehicle used by or for a utility, as
20	defined by Section 203.091, and using visual signals that comply
21	with the standards and specifications adopted under Section

(5) a stationary vehicle used exclusively to transport

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547.105; and

- 1 Safety Code, or recyclable material, as defined by Section 361.421,
- 2 Health and Safety Code, while being operated in connection with the
- 3 removal or transportation of municipal solid waste or recyclable
- 4 material from a location adjacent to the highway.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 547.001(2-b), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (2-b) "Highway maintenance or construction vehicle"
- 8 means a highway or traffic maintenance or construction vehicle
- 9 designated by the Texas Department of Transportation. The term
- 10 includes equipment for:
- 11 (A) road maintenance <u>or construction</u>, including:
- 12 (i) equipment for snow removal, line
- 13 striping, skid resistance testing, sweeping, [and] spraying,
- 14 guardrail repair, sign maintenance, and temporary traffic-control
- 15 <u>device placement or removal;</u>
- 16 (ii) aerial platform lift machines; and
- 17 (iii) road profiler machines; and
- 18 (B) road construction or off-road use, including
- 19 motor graders, road rollers, excavators, pneumatic tire equipment,
- 20 movers, and tractors.
- 21 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 547.105, Transportation
- 22 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 547.105. [MAINTENANCE AND SERVICE VEHICLE] LIGHTING
- 24 STANDARDS FOR CERTAIN VEHICLES.
- 25 SECTION 4. Sections 547.105(a) and (b), Transportation
- 26 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 27 (a) The Texas Department of Transportation shall adopt

- 1 standards and specifications that:
- 2 (1) apply to lamps on highway maintenance or
- 3 <u>construction vehicles</u> and service vehicles; and
- 4 (2) correlate with and conform as closely as possible
- 5 to standards and specifications approved by the American
- 6 Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials.
- 7 (b) The Texas Department of Transportation may adopt
- 8 standards and specifications for lighting that permit the use of
- 9 flashing lights for identification purposes on highway maintenance
- 10 or construction vehicles and service vehicles.
- 11 SECTION 5. Section 547.305(e), Transportation Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (e) A person may not operate a highway maintenance or
- 14 construction vehicle or service vehicle that is not equipped with
- 15 lamps or that does not display lighted lamps as required by the
- 16 standards and specifications adopted by the Texas Department of
- 17 Transportation.
- SECTION 6. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 19 of this Act, the Texas Department of Transportation shall adopt
- 20 standards and specifications relating to lamps and lighting on
- 21 highway construction vehicles, as required by Section 547.105,
- 22 Transportation Code, as amended by this Act.
- 23 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
