H.B. No. 559

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to a fishing license fee waiver for certain residents.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Sections 46.004(b) and (c), Parks and Wildlife
5 Code, are amended to read as follows:

6 (b) The commission may establish a lower fee or waive the
7 fee or license requirement for:

8 (1) a resident who has a general commercial
9 fisherman's license of this state;

10 (2) a resident who is blind as defined by Section
11 355.001 [~~94.001~~], Labor [~~Human Resources~~] Code;

12 (3) a resident or nonresident who is under 17 years
13 old; or

14 (4) a resident who is at least 65 years old but younger
15 than 85 years old or a nonresident who is 65 years old or over.

16 (c) The commission shall waive the fee for:

17 (1) a qualified disabled veteran as defined by Section
18 42.012;

19 (2) [~~and for~~] a resident on active duty as a member of
20 the United States military forces, the Texas Army National Guard,
21 the Texas Air National Guard, or the Texas State Guard; and

22 (3) a resident who is 85 years old or over.

23 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
24 only to a fee charged for a fishing license issued on or after the

1 effective date of this Act.

2 (b) A fishing license issued before the effective date of
3 this Act is covered by the law in effect when the license was
4 issued, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
5 The Parks and Wildlife Department is not required to issue a refund
6 for any license issued before the effective date of this Act.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
