(a) A person commits an 7 offense if the person knowingly or intentionally makes any effort 8 to: 9 (1)influence the independent exercise of the vote of another in the presence of the ballot or during the voting process; 10 11 (2) cause a voter to become registered, a ballot to be 12 obtained, or a vote to be cast under false pretenses; [or] 13 (3) count invalid votes or alter a report to include 14 invalid votes; 15 (4) fail to count valid votes or alter a report to 16 exclude valid votes; or [(3)] <u>(5)</u> cause intentionally misleading 17 any statement, representation, or information to be provided: 18 19 (A) to an election official; or 20 (B) on an application for ballot by mail, carrier 21 envelope, or any other official election-related form or document. 22 (b) An offense under this section is a [Class A misdemeanor] 23 felony of the second degree. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 24
