- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this Act:
- 7 (1) "Artist" means a person who engages in acting,
- 8 dancing, improvisation, singing, and other similar artistic
- 9 performances.
- 10 (2) "Commission" means the Texas Facilities
- 11 Commission.
- 12 (3) "Governmental entity" means this state, a county,
- 13 a municipality, or a school district.
- 14 (4) "Public facility" means a facility owned or
- 15 operated by a governmental entity.
- 16 SECTION 2. STUDY AND REPORT. (a) The commission shall
- 17 conduct a study to assess the availability and suitability of
- 18 existing unused and underused public facilities for joint use by a
- 19 governmental entity and artists for the practice and performance of
- 20 their art or by two governmental entities. The study shall assess
- 21 the economic advantages of those uses.
- (b) Not later than December 1, 2022, the commission shall
- 23 submit to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house
- 24 of representatives, and members of the legislature a written report

- 2 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act expires January 1,
- 3 2023.
- 4 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 5 1, 2021.
