## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a study on the suitability of unused and underused public facilities for joint use by state and local governmental 3 entities. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this Act: 6 (1)7 "Commission" means the Texas Facilities Commission. 8 "Governmental entity" means this state, a county, 9 (2) a municipality, or a school district. 10 (3) 11 "Public facility" means a facility owned or 12 operated by a governmental entity. 13 SECTION 2. STUDY AND REPORT. (a) The commission shall 14 conduct a study to assess the availability and suitability of existing unused and underused public facilities for joint use by 15 16 two governmental entities. The study shall assess the economic advantages of that use. 17 (b) Not later than December 1, 2022, the commission shall 18 submit to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house 19 of representatives, and members of the legislature a written report 20 21 on the results of the study. 22 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act expires January 1, 2023. 23 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September 24
