- 2 relating to public access to personal financial statements filed by

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 572.032, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Financial statements filed under this subchapter are
- 9 public records. The commission shall maintain the statements in
- 10 separate alphabetical files and in a manner that is accessible to
- 11 the public during regular office hours and make each statement
- 12 available to the public on the commission's Internet website not
- 13 <u>later than the 15th day after the date the statement is required to</u>
- 14 be filed or is actually filed, whichever is later.
- 15 (d) The commission is not required to continue to make
- 16 available on its Internet website a financial statement that may be
- 17 <u>destroyed under Subsection (c). The commission may not make</u>
- 18 available on its Internet website a financial statement that the
- 19 commission is required to destroy under Subsection (c).
- SECTION 2. Section 572.032(a-1), Government Code, as
- 21 amended by Chapters 34 (S.B. 1576) and 983 (H.B. 776), Acts of the
- 22 85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, is reenacted and amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- 24 (a-1) The commission shall remove the home address, the

- 1 telephone number, and the names of the dependent children of an
- 2 individual from a financial statement filed by the individual under
- 3 this subchapter before:
- 4 (1) permitting a member of the public to view the
- 5 statement;
- 6 (2) providing a copy of the statement to a member of
- 7 the public; or
- 8 (3) making the statement available to the public on
- 9 the commission's Internet website[, if the commission makes
- 10 statements filed under this subchapter available on its website].
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 572.032(b), Government Code, is
- 12 repealed.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
