2	relating to developing a strategic plan to support the child-care
3	workforce.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 302.0062 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 302.0062. STRATEGIC PLAN TO SUPPORT CHILD-CARE
8	WORKFORCE. (a) The commission shall prepare a strategic plan for
9	improving the quality of the child-care workforce in this state.
10	The strategic plan must include:
11	(1) recommendations for local workforce development
12	boards to improve, sustain, and support the child-care workforce;
13	(2) recommendations for increasing compensation for
14	and reducing turnover of child-care workers;
15	(3) recommendations for eliminating racial and gender
16	pay disparity in the child-care workforce;
17	(4) recommendations for increasing paid opportunities
18	for professional development and education for child-care workers,
19	including apprenticeships;
20	(5) best practices from local workforce development
21	boards in this state and other programs designed to support
22	child-care workers;
23	(6) recommendations for increasing participation in
24	the Texas Early Childhood Professional Development System; and

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1	(7) recommendations for public and private
2	institutions of higher education to:
3	(A) increase the use of articulation agreements
4	with school districts and open-enrollment charter schools; and
5	(B) assist in the education and training of
6	child-care workers.
7	(b) The commission shall use the following information in
8	creating the plan:
9	(1) demographic data of child-care workers in this
10	state, including:
11	(A) the race, ethnicity, gender, and educational
12	attainment of child-care workers; and
13	(B) the ages of the children the worker serves;
14	(2) compensation data for child-care workers
15	disaggregated by race, ethnicity, gender, and educational
16	attainment; and
17	(3) the information described by Subdivisions (1) and
18	(2) for each child-care facility in the state.
19	(c) The commission shall provide the strategic plan
20	prepared under this section to the governor, the lieutenant
21	governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives.
22	(d) The commission shall update the strategic plan prepared
23	under this section every three years.
24	SECTION 2. Not later than December 31, 2022, the Texas
25	Workforce Commission shall make the strategic plan required by
26	Section 302.0062, Labor Code, as added by this Act, available to the
27	governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of

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1 representatives.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
