10	CERTIFICATE. (a) The board shall propose rules under this
11	subchapter to create abbreviated educator preparation programs for
12	a person seeking:
13	(1) a certification to teach courses in marketing; and
14	(2) a certification to teach courses in health science
15	technology.
16	(b) In proposing rules for educator preparation programs
17	under this section, the board shall ensure that:
18	(1) each program requires at least 200 hours of
19	coursework or training; and
20	(2) persons certified under the programs may not be
21	issued additional certifications based on the person's performance
22	on an examination prescribed under Section 21.048.
23	SECTION 2. The State Board for Educator Certification shall
24	propose rules establishing standards to govern the approval and

- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
