- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 361.095, Health and 6 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 361.095. <u>LOCAL PERMITS FOR [APPLICANT FOR]</u> HAZARDOUS
- 8 WASTE MANAGEMENT AND MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE FACILITIES [FACILITY
- 9 PERMIT EXEMPT FROM LOCAL PERMIT].
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 361.095, Health and Safety Code, is
- 11 amended by adding Subsections (a-1) and (g) and amending
- 12 Subsections (b) and (d) to read as follows:
- 13 (a-1) An applicant for a permit under this subchapter is not
- 14 required to obtain a permit for the siting, construction, or
- 15 operation of a municipal solid waste facility from a local
- 16 government or other political subdivision of the state as a
- 17 prerequisite to a permit being issued by the commission.
- 18 (b) A local government or other political subdivision of the
- 19 state may not adopt a rule or ordinance that conflicts with or is
- 20 inconsistent with:

- 21 (1) the requirements for hazardous waste management or
- 22 municipal solid waste facilities as specified by:
- 23 (A) the rules of the commission; or
- (B) $[\frac{by}{a}]$ a permit issued by the commission; or

- 1 (2) the requirements for municipal solid waste
- 2 facilities under Section 361.011.
- 3 (d) The validity or applicability of a rule or ordinance of
- 4 a local government or other political subdivision may be determined
- 5 in an action for declaratory judgment under Chapter 37, Civil
- 6 Practice and Remedies Code, if it is alleged that the rule or
- 7 ordinance, or its threatened application, interferes with, [or]
- 8 impairs, or threatens to interfere with or impair, the legal rights
- 9 or privileges of the plaintiff concerning an issued permit, an
- 10 application for a permit, or the issuance of a permit for the
- 11 siting, construction, or operation of a hazardous waste management
- 12 <u>or municipal solid waste</u> facility.
- 13 (g) This section does not prevent or limit:
- 14 <u>(1) a county or municipality from exercising the</u>
- 15 <u>authority granted under Section 363.112; or</u>
- 16 (2) a county from exercising the authority granted
- 17 under Section 364.012.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
