4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 67, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 67.72 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 67.72. TEXNET TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE. (a) In
8	this section, "program" means the TexNet seismic monitoring program
9	administered by the bureau.
10	(b) The TexNet Technical Advisory Committee is established
11	as an advisory committee within the bureau.
12	(c) The advisory committee consists of nine members
13	appointed by the governor who work or reside in this state,
14	including:
15	(1) one representative of the Railroad Commission of
16	Texas who specializes in seismology, geomechanical engineering,
17	reservoir engineering, or another related field recommended to the
18	governor by the executive director of the Railroad Commission of
19	Texas; and
20	(2) at least three representatives from the oil and
21	gas industry, not to include the representative appointed under
22	Subdivision (1).
23	(d) The governor shall designate a member of the advisory
24	committee as the chair of the advisory committee to serve in that

2	(6) meet with the bureau quarterly to discuss the
3	progress of the program, expenditures made in connection with the
4	program, and any other information related to the program that the
5	advisory committee finds necessary.
6	(h) Not later than December 31 of each even-numbered year,
7	the advisory committee and the bureau jointly shall prepare and
8	submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of
9	the house of representatives a report that includes:
10	(1) a review of the use of any funds appropriated for
11	the program by the legislature;
12	(2) a complete listing and accounting of all research
13	funded through the program, including:
14	(A) a list of contractors employed under the
15	program;
16	(B) an itemized budget for each program element;
17	and
18	(C) a list of the geographic coverage of the
19	program; and
20	(3) recommendations related to the ongoing operations
21	and requirements of the program.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
