- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 775, Health and Safety 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 775.0311 to read as follows:
- Sec. 775.0311. PREVENTIVE HEALTH CARE SERVICES. (a) This
- 8 <u>section applies to a district that is licensed as or contracts with:</u>
- 9 <u>(1) an emergency medical services provider under</u>
- 10 <u>Chapter 773; or</u>

- 11 (2) a first responder organization under Chapter 773.
- (b) In this section, "preventive health care services"
- 13 means out-of-hospital routine health care services, including
- 14 immunizations, screenings, checkups, and patient counseling,
- 15 provided for the purpose of preventing illness, disease, or other
- 16 health problems.
- 17 (c) If approved by the commissioners court of each county in
- 18 which a district is located, the district may provide preventive
- 19 health care services to reduce reliance on 9-1-1 transports and
- 20 systems for routine health care, contract with the state or a local

- 1 (d) A reference in this chapter to the district providing
- 2 emergency services includes preventive health care services.
- 3 (e) A district may make necessary improvements and adopt

- 5 (f) A district in a county with a population of less than
- 6 60,000 must obtain approval from the county commissioners court
- 7 prior to providing services under this section.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
