- 9 (b) For purposes of this section, the effective date of a
- trust is the date the trust becomes irrevocable. 10
- 11 (c) An interest in a trust must vest, if at all:
- 12 (1) not later than 300 years after the effective date
- of the trust, if the effective date of the trust is on or after 13
- 14 September 1, 2021; or
- (2) except as provided by Subsection (d), 15
- [Accordingly, an interest is not good unless it must vest, if at 16
- 17 all, ont later than 21 years after some life in being at the time of
- the creation of the interest, plus a period of gestation, if the 18
- effective date of the trust is before September 1, 2021. 19
- 20 (d) An interest in a trust that has an effective date before
- 21 September 1, 2021, may vest as described by Subsection (c)(1) if the
- trust instrument provides that an interest in the trust vests under 22
