- 9 Sec. 261.3091. NOTICE OF RIGHT TO REQUEST ADMINISTRATIVE
- 10 REVIEW. (a) Before conducting an interview with an alleged
- 11 perpetrator, the department shall provide written notice to the
- 12 person that the person may request an administrative review of the
- 13 <u>department's findings under Section 261.309</u>. The person shall sign
- 14 the written notice to acknowledge receipt of the notice.
- 15 (b) The department shall document in the case file that the
- 16 department provided the notice required by Subsection (a).
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
