- 5 SECTION 1. Section 20.01, Penal Code, is amended by adding

- 9 <u>(7) "Special investigator" includes an agent of the</u>

- 11 SECTION 2. Sections 20.05(a) and (b), Penal Code, are

- 2 (b) An offense under this section is a felony of the third
- 3 degree, except that the offense is:

- 7 will suffer serious bodily injury or death; [or]
- 8 (B) the smuggled individual is a child younger
- 9 than 18 years of age at the time of the offense;
- 10 (C) the offense was committed with the intent to
- 11 <u>obtain a pecuniary benefit;</u>
- 12 (D) during the commission of the offense the
- 13 actor, another party to the offense, or an individual assisted,
