| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 3, Government Code, is amended |
| 6 | by adding Chapter 315A to read as follows: |
| 7 | CHAPTER 315A. CHILDHOOD RACIAL DISPARITY IMPACT STATEMENT |
| 8 | Sec. 315A.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "state agency" |
| 9 | has the meaning assigned by Section 315.002. |
| 10 | Sec. 315A.002. CHILDHOOD RACIAL DISPARITY IMPACT |
| 11 | STATEMENT. (a) At the request of the lieutenant governor or |
| 12 | speaker of the house of representatives, a state agency shall |
| 13 | prepare a childhood racial disparity impact statement for any bill |
| 14 | or joint resolution pending before the legislature that directly |
| 15 | affects that agency. Preparation of the statement shall be |
| 16 | coordinated through the director of the Legislative Budget Board. |
| 17 | (b) A childhood racial disparity impact statement must |
| 18 | <pre>include:</pre> |
| 19 | (1) a brief description of the nature and effect of the |
| 20 | proposal; and |
| 21 | (2) a statement of the manner and extent to which the |
| 22 | proposal, if implemented, will directly or indirectly during each |
| 23 | of the two years following its effective date: |

(A) increase or decrease racial disparities

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- 1 among children under the age of 18 in the state, including the
- 2 number of children affected and the geographic area affected;
- 3 (B) affect the manner in which local governments
- 4 operate that may result in an increase or decrease in childhood
- 5 racial disparities; and
- 6 (C) impact childhood racial disparities in the
- 7 state other than those specifically described by this subdivision.
- 8 <u>(c) A childhood racial disparity impact statement that</u>
- 9 omits information required by this section must:
- 10 (1) specifically note the omission;
- 11 (2) state the reason for the omission; and
- 12 (3) estimate the additional time and effort required
- 13 to obtain the information.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
