Section 372.053, Transportation Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a-1) and adding Subsections (c), (d), and 8 (e) to read as follows: 9 (a-1) A program established under Subsection (a) must 10 11 include free or discounted use of the entity's toll project by a 12 vehicle associated with an account of an electronic toll collection customer who is eligible to be issued license plates [whose account 13 14 relates to a vehicle registered] under Section 504.202, 504.305(a)(1), [or] 504.315(f) or (g), or 504.512. 15 (c) Notwithstanding Sections 228.057(e), 366.179(d), 16 370.178(d), and 372.051(a), a toll project entity that has an 17 electronic toll collection customer who participates in the 18 entity's discount program shall provide to any other toll project 19 entity with a discount program the information necessary for the 20 customer to participate in that entity's discount program. 21 (d) A toll project entity that establishes a discount 22 23 program for electronic toll collection customers: 24 (1) shall adopt a process to allow a customer whose

2	plates described by Subsection (a-1) to establish eligibility to
3	participate in the program; and
4	(2) may not require the display of license plates
5	described by Subsection (a-1) as a condition of participation in
6	the program.
7	(e) The department shall maintain on its Internet website a
8	map that accurately displays all toll projects, including toll
9	projects of other toll project entities, for which an electronic
10	toll collection customer is eligible for free or discounted use
11	under Subsection (a-1). Each toll project entity that operates a
12	toll project included in the map shall display the map on its
13	Internet website.
14	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
