5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 551.128(b-1), Government Code, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	(b-1) A transit authority or department subject to Chapter
9	451, 452, 453, or 460, Transportation Code, [an elected school
10	district board of trustees for a school district that has a student
11	enrollment of 10,000 or more, an elected governing body of a
12	home-rule municipality that has a population of 50,000 or more, or a
13	county commissioners court for] a county that has a population of
14	5,000 [125,000] or more, and any political subdivision located
15	wholly or partly in a county that has a population of 5,000 or more
16	shall:
17	(1) make a video and audio recording of reasonable
18	quality of each:

- 19 (A) regularly scheduled open meeting that is not
- 20 a work session or a special called meeting; and
- 21 (B) open meeting that is a work session or
- 22 special called meeting if:
- (i) the governmental body is an elected

- 1 student enrollment of 10,000 or more; and
- 2 (ii) at the work session or special called
- 3 meeting, the board of trustees votes on any matter or allows public
- 4 comment or testimony; and
- 5 (2) make available an archived copy of the video and
- 6 audio recording of each meeting described by Subdivision (1) on the
- 7 Internet.
- 8 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 9 an open meeting held on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 10 open meeting held before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 11 by the law in effect on the date of the open meeting, and the former
- 12 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
