- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, is 5
- amended by adding Chapter 53 to read as follows: 6
- CHAPTER 53. BONE MARROW DONOR RECRUITMENT PROGRAM 7
- Sec. 53.001. ESTABLISHMENT OF PROGRAM. (a) The department 8
- 9 shall establish a bone marrow donor recruitment program to educate
- residents of this state about: 10
- (1) the need for bone marrow donors, including the 11
- 12 particular need for donors from minority populations;
- 13 (2) the requirements for registering with the
- 14 federally authorized bone marrow donor registry established and
- maintained as required by 42 U.S.C. Section 274k as a potential bone 15
- 16 marrow donor, including procedures for determining an individual's
- 17 tissue type;
- 18 (3) the medical procedures an individual must undergo
- to donate bone marrow or other sources of blood stem cells; and 19
- (4) the availability of information about bone marrow 20
- 21 donation in health care facilities, blood banks, and driver's

- (b) The department, in consultation with the federally 23
- authorized bone marrow donor registry established and maintained as 2.4

- 3 websites and machine-readable codes, regarding:
- 4 (1) bone marrow donation; and
- 5 (2) the process of registering with the federally

- 7 (c) The federally authorized bone marrow donor registry may
- 8 develop and provide the informational materials described by
- 9 Subsection (b) to the department.
- 10 (d) The department and the Department of Public Safety shall
- 11 post the information described by Subsection (b) on each agency's
- 12 respective Internet websites.
- 13 (e) Appropriate health care facilities, blood banks, and
- 14 driver's license offices may access the informational materials
- 15 described by Subsection (b) on the Internet websites of the
- 16 department and the Department of Public Safety and print the
- 17 materials to place in their facilities, banks, or offices to
- 18 provide to residents of this state.
- 19 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
