## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 129.001, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 129.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "public safety
- 8 employee" means a peace officer, firefighter, detention officer,
- 9 county jailer,  $[\frac{\partial \mathbf{r}}{\partial t}]$  emergency medical services employee, or
- 10 <a href="mailto:emergency service dispatcher">emergency service dispatcher</a> of this state or a political
- 11 subdivision of this state.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 13 person who, on or after the effective date of this Act, enters a
- 14 public safety employees treatment court program created under
- 15 Chapter 129, Government Code, regardless of whether the person
- 16 entering the program committed the offense for which the person
- 17 enters the program before, on, or after the effective date of this
- 18 Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
