A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the eligibility of emergency service dispatchers to 3 participate in a public safety employees treatment court program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 129.001, Government Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

Sec. 129.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "public safety employee" means a peace officer, firefighter, detention officer, county jailer, [or] emergency medical services employee, or <u>emergency service dispatcher</u> of this state or a political subdivision of this state.

12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a 13 person who, on or after the effective date of this Act, enters a 14 public safety employees treatment court program created under 15 Chapter 129, Government Code, regardless of whether the person 16 entering the program committed the offense for which the person 17 enters the program before, on, or after the effective date of this 18 Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
