A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of certain municipalities to use an

3 alternate work schedule for police dispatchers.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 142.0015, Local Government Code, is

6 amended by adding Subsection (k) to read as follows:

7 (k) For purposes of this subsection, "police dispatcher"

8 means an operator or dispatcher employed by a municipal police

9 department who provides communication support services for the

10 police department by responding to requests for assistance. If a

11 majority of police dispatchers for a municipal police department

12 vote in favor of an alternate work schedule, the municipality may

13 adopt an alternate work schedule for the department's dispatchers.

14 A dispatcher working under an alternate work schedule adopted under

15 this subsection is entitled to overtime pay if the dispatcher works

16 more hours during a calendar month than the number of hours in the

17 <u>normal work month of the majority of the employees of the</u>

18 municipality other than fire fighters and police officers.

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
