5	SECTION 1. Section 142.0062(a), Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) A home and community support services agency or its
8	employees who are registered nurses or licensed vocational nurses
9	may purchase, store, or transport for the purpose of administering
10	to the agency's employees, home health or hospice patients, or
11	patient family members under physician's standing orders the
12	following dangerous drugs:
13	(1) hepatitis B vaccine;
14	(2) influenza vaccine;
15	(3) tuberculin purified protein derivative for
16	tuberculosis testing; [and]
17	(4) pneumococcal polysaccharide vaccine; and
18	(5) any other vaccine approved, authorized for
19	emergency use, or otherwise permitted for use by the United States
20	Food and Drug Administration to treat or mitigate the spread of a
21	communicable disease, as defined by Section 81.003.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
