7	(8-a) "Quick draw lottery game" means a lottery game
8	in which a drawing occurs 12 to 15 times per hour between the hours
9	of 7 a.m. and 2 a.m.
10	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 466, Government Code, is
11	amended by adding Section 466.029 to read as follows:
12	Sec. 466.029. QUICK DRAW LOTTERY GAME; SALES AGENT LICENSE
13	FOR QUICK DRAW LOTTERY GAME. (a) The commission shall operate a
14	quick draw lottery game. The commission shall:
15	(1) determine the ticket price, payout amounts, and
16	manner in which the game is conducted;
17	(2) restrict the locations authorized to sell the
18	quick draw lottery game tickets to only locations licensed as sales
19	agents in accordance with Subsection (b); and
20	(3) ensure the game remains competitive with other
21	lottery games offered by the commission.
22	(b) The commission may license as sales agents to sell quick
23	draw lottery game tickets only holders of one of the following
24	permits or licenses issued by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage

10	(8) a distiller's and rectifier's permit.
11	(c) Section 466.155(a)(4)(C) does not apply to a sales agent

13	(d) The commission shall market and advertise the lottery

16	licensed sales agents described by Subsection (b).

19	SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
20	of this Act but not later than January 1, 2022, the Texas Lottery
21	Commission shall implement Section 466.029, Government Code, as
22	added by this Act, by adopting all necessary rules and procedures,
23	issuing sales agent licenses, and establishing the quick draw
