- 7 SECTION 1. Section 411.0725(e), Government Code, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (e) A person may petition the court that placed the person
- 10 on deferred adjudication community supervision for an order of
- 11 nondisclosure of criminal history record information under this
- 12 section only on or after:
- 13 (1) the discharge and dismissal, if the offense for
- 14 which the person was placed on deferred adjudication was a
- 15 misdemeanor other than a misdemeanor described by Subdivision
- 16 (2)(A) $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$;
- 17 (2) the <u>first</u> [<u>second</u>] anniversary of the discharge
- 18 and dismissal, if the offense for which the person was placed on
- 19 deferred adjudication was:
- 20 <u>(A)</u> a misdemeanor under Chapter 20, 21, 22, 25,
- 21 42, 43, or 46, Penal Code; or
- (B) a state jail felony listed in Article
- 23 <u>42A.551(a)</u>, Code of Criminal Procedure; or
- 24 (3) the third [fifth] anniversary of the discharge and

- 1 dismissal, if the offense for which the person was placed on
- 2 deferred adjudication was a felony other than a state jail felony
- 3 <u>described by Subdivision (2)(B)</u>.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
