12	authorized to:
13	(1) immobilize a vehicle parked in the municipality;
14	[and]
15	(2) remove an immobilized vehicle from a public
16	roadway in the municipality; and
17	(3) request the removal and storage of a vehicle that
18	is located in an area where on-street parking is regulated by the
19	ordinance and that:
20	(A) is parked illegally; or
21	(B) is parked legally and:
22	(i) has been unattended for more than 48
23	hours; and
24	(ii) the employee has reasonable grounds to

1 believe is abandoned.

2 (b) A parking facility owner or towing company may not3 remove a vehicle from a public roadway except under:

4 (1) this chapter or a municipal ordinance that 5 complies with Section 2308.208; or

6 (2) the direction of a peace officer, a municipal 7 employee under Subsection (a)(3), or the owner or operator of the 8 vehicle.

9 (c) <u>Subsection</u> [In addition to the authority granted under 10 <u>Subsection (a) and to aid in the enforcement of an ordinance</u> 11 <u>regulating the parking of vehicles, a municipality with a</u> 12 <u>population of 1.9 million or more may authorize a designated</u> 13 <u>employee to request the removal of a vehicle parked illegally in an</u> 14 <u>area designated as a tow-away zone in a residential area where</u> 15 <u>on-street parking is regulated by the ordinance.</u>

16 [(d) Subsections] (a) does [and (c) do] not apply to a 17 vehicle owned by an electric, gas, water, or telecommunications 18 utility while the vehicle is parked for the purpose of conducting 19 work on a facility of the utility that is located below, above, or 20 adjacent to the street.
