- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 31.032(d), Human Resources Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (d) In determining whether an applicant is eligible for
- 9 assistance, the commission shall exclude from the applicant's
- 10 available resources:
- 11 (1) \$10,000 [\$1,000] for the applicant's household,
- 12 including a household in which there is a person with a disability
- 13 or a person who is at least 60 years of age; and
- 14 (2) the combined fair market value of all motor
- 15 vehicles in which the applicant has an [applicant's] ownership
- 16 interest, not to exceed \$25,000 [in a motor vehicle, but not more
- 17 than \$5,000 plus or minus an amount to be determined annually
- 18 beginning on October 1, 1997, to reflect changes in the new car
- 19 component of the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers
- 20 published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics].
- 21 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 33, Human Resources Code,
- 22 is amended by adding Section 33.021 to read as follows:
- 23 <u>Sec. 33.021. EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN RESOURCES IN DETERMINING</u>
- 24 SNAP ELIGIBILITY. In determining the eligibility of an applicant

- 1 for or recertifying the eligibility of a recipient of supplemental
- 2 nutrition assistance benefits, the commission shall exclude from
- 3 the applicant's or recipient's available resources:
- 4 (1) \$10,000 for the applicant's household; and
- 5 (2) the combined fair market value of all motor
- 6 vehicles in which the applicant or recipient has an ownership
- 7 interest, not to exceed \$25,000.
- 8 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to:
- 9 (1) an initial determination or redetermination of
- 10 eligibility of a person for financial assistance under Chapter 31,
- 11 Human Resources Code, that is made on or after the effective date of
- 12 this Act; and
- 13 (2) an initial determination or recertification of
- 14 eligibility of a person for the supplemental nutrition assistance
- 15 program under Chapter 33, Human Resources Code, that is made on or
- 16 after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 4. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 18 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 19 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 20 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 21 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 22 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
