## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the operation of motor-assisted scooters.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 551.351(1), Transportation Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	<pre>(1) "Motor-assisted scooter":</pre>
7	(A) means a self-propelled device with:
8	(i) at least two wheels in contact with the
9	ground during operation;
10	(ii) a braking system capable of stopping
11	the device under typical operating conditions;
12	(iii) a gas motor with a displacement not
13	exceeding 40 cubic centimeters or an electric motor with a power
14	<pre>output not exceeding 2,000 watts [40 cubic centimeters];</pre>
15	(iv) a deck designed to allow a person to
16	stand or sit while operating the device; and
17	(v) the ability to be propelled by human
18	power alone; and
19	(B) does not include a pocket bike or a
20	minimotorbike.
21	SECTION 2. The heading to Section 551.352, Transportation
22	Code, is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Section 551.352, Transportation Code, is amended

Sec. 551.352. OPERATION ON ROADWAYS [OR SIDEWALKS].

- 1 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 2 follows:
- 3 (a) A person may operate a motor-assisted scooter [may be
- 4 operated only] on a street or highway only:
- 5 (1) in a bicycle lane; or
- 6 (2) on a street or highway without a bicycle lane if:
- 7 (A) [for which] the posted speed limit is 30 [35]
- 8 miles per hour or less; and
- 9 (B) the operator complies with Section 551.103,
- 10 regardless of whether the operator is moving slower than the other
- 11 traffic on the roadway.
- 12 (a-1) A [The] motor-assisted scooter on a street or highway
- 13 <u>without a bicycle lane</u> may cross a <u>highway</u> [<del>road</del>] or street at an
- 14 intersection where the highway [road] or street has a posted speed
- 15 limit of more than 30 [35] miles per hour.
- SECTION 4. Sections 551.352(b) and (c), Transportation
- 17 Code, are redesignated as Section 551.354, Transportation Code, and
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 551.354. LOCAL AND DEPARTMENT REGULATION. (a)
- 20 [<del>(b)</del>] A county or municipality may:
- 21 (1) further restrict the speed at which a person may
- 22 <u>operate a motor-assisted scooter;</u>
- 23 (2) further restrict the locations a person may
- 24 operate a motor-assisted scooter;
- 25 (3) impose a minimum age requirement for the operator
- 26 of a motor-assisted scooter;
- 27 (4) impose a higher criminal or civil penalty for a

- 1 violation of a traffic law by an operator of a motor-assisted
- 2 scooter;
- 3 (5) restrict the locations a person may park a
- 4 motor-assisted scooter;
- 5 (6) require the operator of a motor-assisted scooter
- 6 to wear a safety helmet; or
- 7 (7) prohibit the operation of a motor-assisted scooter
- 8 on a street, highway, or sidewalk if the governing body of the
- 9 county or municipality determines that the prohibition is necessary
- 10 in the interest of safety.
- 11 (b) [(c)] The department may prohibit the operation of a
- 12 motor-assisted scooter on a highway if it determines that the
- 13 prohibition is necessary in the interest of safety.
- 14 SECTION 5. Section 551.352(d), Transportation Code, is
- 15 redesignated as Sections 551.3521 and 551.3522, Transportation
- 16 Code, and amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 551.3521. OPERATION ON SIDEWALKS AND OTHER AREAS
- 18 PRIMARILY FOR NONMOTORIZED TRAFFIC. [<del>(d)</del>] A person may operate a
- 19 motor-assisted scooter on a path set aside primarily for the use of
- 20 <u>nonmotorized traffic, including</u> [exclusive operation of bicycles
- 21 or on a sidewalk.
- Sec. 551.3522. APPLICABILITY OF BICYCLE AND MOTOR VEHICLE
- 23 LAWS. (a) Except as otherwise provided by this subchapter
- 24 [section], a provision of this title applicable to the operation of
- 25 a bicycle applies to the operation of a motor-assisted scooter.
- SECTION 6. Section 551.352(e), Transportation Code, is
- 27 transferred to Section 551.3522, Transportation Code, as added by

- H.B. No. 934
- 1 this Act, and redesignated as Section 551.3522(b), Transportation
- 2 Code, to read as follows:
- 3 (b)  $\frac{(e)}{(e)}$  A provision of this title applicable to a motor
- 4 vehicle does not apply to a motor-assisted scooter.
- 5 SECTION 7. Subchapter E, Chapter 551, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Sections 551.355, 551.356, and 551.357 to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 Sec. 551.355. LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF RIDERS. A person may
- 9 not use a motor-assisted scooter to carry more than one person.
- Sec. 551.356. LIMITATION ON SPEED. A person may not operate
- 11 <u>a motor-assisted scooter at a speed that exceeds:</u>
- 12 (1) 15 miles per hour if the person is standing; or
- 13 (2) 20 miles per hour if the person is seated.
- 14 Sec. 551.357. REQUIREMENT TO YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS. A
- 15 person operating a motor-assisted scooter shall yield the
- 16 <u>right-of-way to a pedestrian.</u>
- 17 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
