- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 37.143, Education Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 37.143. <u>ISSUANCE OF</u> CITATION [PROHIBITED]; CUSTODY OF
- 8 CHILD.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 37.143(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 10 read as follows:
- 11 (a) A peace officer, law enforcement officer, or school
- 12 resource officer may not issue a citation to a child who is alleged
- 13 to have committed a school offense unless the child is alleged to
- 14 have committed the offense while the child was in a disciplinary
- 15 alternative education program.
- SECTION 3. Section 37.145, Education Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 37.145. <u>CITATION OR COMPLAINT</u>. <u>If a child is alleged</u>
- 19 to have committed a school offense:
- 20 <u>(1) a peace officer, law enforcement officer, or</u>
- 21 school resource officer may issue a citation to the child, if the
- 22 issuance of a citation is authorized under Section 37.143; or
- 23 (2) [If a child fails to comply with or complete
- 24 graduated sanctions under Section 37.144, or if the school district

- 1 has not elected to adopt a system of graduated sanctions under that
- 2 $\frac{\text{section}_{r}}{\text{section}_{r}}$] the school may file a complaint against the child with a
- 3 criminal court in accordance with Section 37.146, if the child
- 4 fails to comply with or complete graduated sanctions under Section
- 5 37.144 or if the school district has not elected to adopt a system
- 6 of graduated sanctions under that section.
- 7 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 8 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 9 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 10 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 11 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 12 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 13 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 14 before that date.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
