## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the adoption of uniform general conditions for building
- 3 construction contracts entered into by school districts and the
- 4 composition of the committee that reviews uniform general
- 5 conditions.

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- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 44, Education Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 44.035 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 44.035. ADOPTION OF UNIFORM GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR
- 10 SCHOOL DISTRICT BUILDING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS. After reviewing
- 11 the uniform general conditions adopted by the Texas Facilities
- 12 <u>Commission under Section 2166.302</u>, <u>Government Code</u>, a <u>school</u>
- 13 district may adopt uniform general conditions to be incorporated in
- 14 all district building construction contracts.
- SECTION 2. Section 2166.305(b), Government Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (b) A committee appointed by the commission shall perform
- 18 the review. The committee consists of:
- 19 (1) the director of facilities construction and space
- 20 management appointed under Section 2152.104, who serves as the
- 21 presiding officer of the committee;
- 22 (2) six individuals appointed by the commission, one
- 23 each from the lists of nominees submitted respectively by the:
- 24 (A) president of the Texas Society of Architects;

- 1 (B) president of the Texas Society of
- 2 Professional Engineers;
- 3 (C) presiding officer of the Executive Council of
- 4 the Texas Associated General Contractors Chapters;
- 5 (D) executive secretary of the Mechanical
- 6 Contractors Associations of Texas, Incorporated;
- 7 (E) executive secretary of the Texas Building and
- 8 Construction Trades Council; and
- 9 (F) president of the Associated Builders and
- 10 Contractors of Texas;
- 11 (3) one individual appointed by the commission
- 12 representing an institution of higher education, as defined by
- 13 Section 61.003, Education Code;
- 14 (4) one individual appointed by the commission
- 15 representing a state agency that has a substantial ongoing
- 16 construction program;
- 17 (5) one individual appointed by the commission
- 18 representing the attorney general's office;
- 19 (6) one individual appointed by the commission
- 20 representing the interests of historically underutilized
- 21 businesses; [and]
- 22 (7) two individuals appointed by the commission, each
- 23 representing a different minority contractors association;
- 24 (8) one individual appointed by the commission
- 25 representing the Texas Association of School Boards; and
- 26 (9) one individual appointed by the commission
- 27 representing the Texas Association of School Administrators.

- 1 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2021, the Texas
- 2 Facilities Commission shall appoint two additional members to the
- 3 committee in accordance with Section 2166.305(b), Government Code,
- 4 as amended by this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
